With the long Memorial Day weekend coming up, no work that affects traffic will be done after noon on Friday 05/22/15 to 7:00 AM on Tuesday 05/26/15 for the Holiday weekend. The only exception would be the pouring of the southeast retaining wall footing if it is not completed Friday morning.

Work Activity on Route 5

This week the contractor will be continuing on-going tasks that will mostly be done behind barriers. There will be traffic delays while concrete trucks pour concrete and other delays when equipment and material are moved in the construction zone. Flaggers will direct traffic during the day.

PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE.

Work will continue on forming bridge abutments including:

- Installing retaining (wingwall) wall footing forms
- Installing rebar at all abutments
- pouring of concrete for abutment/wingwall footings

Work Activity along I-91

There will be work done in the median on I-91 northbound and southbound all week, during which one lane will be closed.
