

## **Weekly Preview Monday 06/22/15 – Saturday 06/27/15**

Hello,

The erection of the beams for both new highway bridges has been completed and installation of the deck panels (see photos below) on top of the girders has begun. Contractors will be working overhead on Route 5 tensioning and checking bolted connections, forming overhang on outside girders and setting fall protection netting on the outside girders.

The contractor will continue to work on forming the bridge substructure – installing rebar, footings and retaining walls. It is expected this work, mostly done behind barriers, will be completed by mid-July.

There is the potential for lane closures on I-91 Northbound and Southbound during the week while work is done on the approach slabs.

### **TRAFFIC WARNING!**

Traffic impact on Route 5 will be heavy and motorists can expect this condition to continue for several weeks. It is highly recommended that motorists avoid the construction area and seek alternate routes. Here's when delays will occur:

- **Monday-Friday at 9:00am-3:00pm and Saturday 7:00-3:00.** Work done overhead Route 5 will require running alternating one way traffic or traffic stoppage and there will be up to **10 minute delays.**
- During the night on **Sunday-Friday at 6:00 pm-6:00 am** there will be **longer than 10 minute delays.**

During long periods of alternating one-way traffic, the temporary signals will be put on flash and manned by uniformed police officers. If necessary, motorists may be motioned by police to find an alternate route, to keep the off ramps from backing up to I-91.

**Please drive with caution through the work zone.**
