

Weekly Traffic Update
Monday 04/27/15 – Saturday 05/02/15

Route 5 Traffic Signal at Exit 11 northbound ramp

On Tuesday, the signals will be changed. The new signal will have both a green and red turn arrow. When traffic on Route 5 has the green signal, the signal at the ramp will be a blinking red arrow. The blinking (red arrow) light will allow drivers to proceed onto Route 5 as long as there is a gap in traffic.

Work Activity on Route 5

This week the contractor will be continuing on-going tasks and beginning new activities that will mostly be done behind barriers. There will be traffic delays while concrete trucks pour concrete and other delays when equipment and material are moved in the construction zone. Flaggers will direct traffic during the day.

PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING THROUGH THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE.

Work will continue on:

- Removing ledge
- Drilling micropiles...on the northwest and southwest abutments

New work includes:

- Forming abutment and wingwall footings
- Installing rebar for abutment and wingwall footings
- Pouring of concrete for southeast and northeast abutments
- Installing crane mats for the falsework that will support (temporarily) the construction of the new bridges next to the existing bridges

Work Activity along I-91

A guardrail and barrier will be installed on I-91 northbound and southbound Monday – Wednesday to create a safe work area in the median. This will result in a left lane closure during the day.
